ELIGIBILITY

The student invitational is open to all Washington Co. student artists in grades Pre-Kindergarten - Twelve.

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

Artwork of any medium, including but not limited to paintings, original prints, drawings, graphics, photographs, ceramics, and 3D sculptures may be entered. Artwork does NOT have to be framed or matted to be considered for judging; however, if artwork is entered without being mounted on construction paper or with a mat, the Greenville Arts Council may add one for display purposes. If your student artist would prefer not to have their work mounted, please specify on the form. All efforts will be made to return the artwork in the condition it is submitted, but please be aware that small tears may result from the hanging process.

ENTRY SPECIFICATIONS

Entries will be judged in person by the juror. **All entries must be submitted with the attached form at the Greenville Arts Council, 323 South Main, between 10:00 and 4:00 p.m., beginning on Wednesday, April 13, and no later than Thursday, April 14.** Students may only submit **one** piece of artwork unless they are also participating in a group project. Information for Teachers:

1. **Drop Off**: Art work can be delivered April 13th through April 14th, which is deadline for entry.
Location: Greenville Arts Council, E. E. Bass Building, 323 South Main St.
2. **Art Identification**: Student identification information must be attached to the piece being entered.
3. **Student Artist Entry Form** must be submitted with each piece.
4. **Printed Labels**: We will be printing labels for each piece here in our office. Please! As soon as you have made a selection of pieces to be entered, forward a list to me, with students name, age and school, title of work and medium. This can be done before the art is delivered. This would allow my printing the labels in a timely manner.
5. **Goals**: We want to provide an experience that is both educational and fun!
6. **Opening Reception**: As with our other artists' openings, we are planning a reception on Thursday, April 21, 2022, from 4:00-6:00 pm. Light refreshments will be served and artists can walk among the work and talk with family and friends.
7. **Exhibit Dates**; April 21st- April 27th. Two steam boats will be docking in Greenville during this time. Visitors often come to Bass to see the Carousel and our art gallery. This will be a great opportunity for people to see and recognize the talented young people we have in our community.
